ec. 16-1. Riding on fire apparatus.

It shall be unlawful for any person, except a member of the fire department, to ride on any truck, vehicle or apparatus of the department while going to or returning from a fire, except by permission of the chief of the fire department. (Code 1973, § 9-5)

Sec. 16-2. Interfering with volunteer firefighter en route to fire.

It shall be unlawful for any person to interfere in any manner with a volunteer firefighter en route to a fire if such firefighter is prominently displaying warning lights. (Code 1973, § 9-2)
